Month	Topics and Content	Resources	Comments
September 3 sessions	<p>Session One - Getting Acquainted and organized</p> <p><i>Session Two will include a fire drill</i></p> <p>Brief of review of what they learned in second grade and connect it to belonging to the church.</p> <p>Introduce the Rosary.</p> <p>Preview the Apostles' Creed.</p>	<p>Sadlier chapters 15, 16, 17, 18 can be resources.</p> <p>Ask us for little Rosary booklets; also posters of the mysteries.</p> <p>Apostles' Creed powerpoint is online. Can be used later, too; Chapter 9 of Sadlier</p>	<p>Not all third graders were in second grade last year. Some are new to the program.</p> <p>You can also make a Apostle's Creed folder for them to practice with. Ask me in advance for instructions and materials.</p>

<p>October</p> <p>5 sessions</p>	<p>Begin with the promise of the Spirit and continue through Pentecost.</p> <p>Key is understanding that the Holy Spirit is the third person of the Trinity, is given to us in baptism, and is what helps the church to do the work of Jesus.</p> <p>Help students understand that our parish church is part of larger whole - the bishops and the Pope.</p>	<p>You can match this with the Glorious Mysteries.</p> <p>Sadlier chapters 3, 4, 5 of the text can be a resource.</p> <p>Read the accounts of Jesus' promise of the Spirit (John 14) Resurrection, Ascension and Pentecost from the Catholic Children's Bible.</p> <p>Sadlier chapters 11 and 12 can be resources as well as chapter 24.</p>	<p>October is the Month of the Rosary.</p> <p>Skits and crafts to reinforce Pentecost are available.</p> <p>Bring in bulletins and have the students try to explain what our church is doing in their own words.</p> <p>Talk about how families, formed through the sacrament of marriage, are a cornerstone of the parish and whole church.</p> <p>We have a book on who/what the Pope is.</p> <p>We can make posters of examples of various ministries.</p>
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<p>November</p> <p>3 sessions</p>	<p>Finish up the structure of the church if necessary.</p> <p>Communion of saints and Mary as connected to the church</p> <p>Begin to memorize the Apostles' Creed.</p> <p><i>No class on Nov 27</i></p>	<p>Connect All Saints and All Souls to 'life everlasting' in the Apostles Creed.</p> <p>Assumption and Coronation of Mary can be prayed here.</p> <p>Sadlier chapters 25 and 26 are resources.</p> <p>Connecting Eucharist with Thanksgiving could be a good review in this month. Sadlier chapters 16 and 17 can be resources.</p>	<p>See Cathy for resources about saints.</p> <p>Idea: Have them do a little prayer card of each student trying to become a saint.</p> <p>See Cathy for worksheet on Apostles Creed - looking up the relevant Scripture passages.</p>
<p>December</p> <p>2 sessions</p>	<p><i>Will include Advent candle lighting at the beginning of first week.</i></p> <p><i>No class on Dec 11 due to OL Guadalupe traffic</i></p> <p><i>Third week is Adoration and Christmas treat</i></p> <p><i>Need to cover Advent and Christmas;</i></p>	<p>The Joyful Mysteries can be prayed here.</p> <p>There are Advent and Christmas lessons in Sadlier.</p> <p>Review of the liturgical year is good.</p> <p>Read about the Annunciation and Christmas in the Catholic Children's Bible. (Luke 1 and 2; Matthew 1 and 2)</p>	<p>There are Advent/Christmas saint story books you might want to work in here.</p> <p>See Cathy for material on OL Guadalupe and St. Juan Diego</p>

<p>January</p> <p>4 sessions</p>	<p>Begin Thematic Unit Two</p> <p>Continue to work on finding things in the Bible.</p> <p>Understanding of life in the time of Jesus and his life as a Jew.</p> <p>Continue to work on memorizing the Apostle's Creed.</p>	<p>Finish the Joyful Mysteries and continue with Luminous.</p> <p>Chapters 1 and 2 are resources here.</p>	<p>There is a song that they can use to memorize the books of the New Testament.</p> <p>There are resources to teach about Bible Times and Judaism to kids. Sadlier Chapter 23 can be a resource. See Cathy for 'daily life' in Bible times resources.</p>
<p>February</p> <p>4 sessions</p>	<p><i>Do prep for Lent on February 19.</i></p> <p><i>Feb 26 is Ash Wednesday. We'll go to the 7 PM mass. (Session will dismiss from church at the end of mass.)</i></p> <p>Continue with the miracles and parables of Jesus.</p> <p>Continue to memorize the Apostles' Creed.</p>	<p>Consult the curriculum for passages and use the Catholic Children's Bible.</p> <p>Connect Jesus' healing miracles to the anointing of the sick. Chapter 19 of text.</p> <p>Resource chapter on Lent in the text.</p>	<p>There are many skit scripts available. Kids like making up their own, too.</p>

<p>March 3 sessions</p>	<p><i>Grades three through seven go to confession - 1/2 session on either Mar 18 or Apr 1 . All classes do Stations of the Cross; half session on either March 4 or March 11.</i></p> <p><i>March 25 off due to school break</i></p> <p>Thematic Unit Three -</p> <p>Work on understanding the articles of the Apostles' Creed.</p> <p>Review going to confession.</p>	<p>Move to Sorrowful Mysteries.</p> <p>Chapter 18 of text</p> <p>Sadlier chapters 8 and 9 are a resource. Also, tie in to chapters 3 and 4</p>	<p>There are posters and other materials to review the Stations of the Cross.</p>
<p>April 3 sessions</p>	<p><i>Grades three through seven go to confession - 1/2 session on either Mar 18 or Apr 1 .</i></p> <p><i>No class on April 8 - Holy Week</i></p> <p><i>Child safety on April 22</i></p> <p>One session to wrap up memorizing the Creed, if needed.</p> <p>Connect Jesus' sacrifice to our mission to be Christ in the world. (Thematic Unit Four)</p>	<p>Chapter 22 of text.</p>	
<p>May 1 session</p>	<p><i>Rosary and May Crowning; awards and closing party on May 6</i></p>		

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
