Prayers and Prayer Practices

St. Emily Religious Education First through Conf III / Eighth Grade

Please note that if a prayer or prayer method is learned earlier, it can (and should) certainly be practiced in class later! Middle school can say the rosary and pray the Examen, Eighth/Conf III can pray the prayer to the Holy Spirit, etc.

First:

- Basic responses for the mass;
- Be able to discuss how to pray and when we pray
- Sign of the Cross
- Glory be to the Father
- Hail Mary
- Our Father
- Grace before meals
- Be able to compose their own short prayers out loud
- Be able to describe how to pray
- Be familiar with silent prayer
- Firmly know the above prayers
- Be introduced to the Rosary and the Stations of the Cross
- Meditative prayer the 'Five-Finger' prayer at least once a week

Second:

- Further mass responses, including the Holy, Lamb of God.
- Act of Contrition
- Know a prayer of thanksgiving to say after receiving communion
- Be introduced to Eucharistic Adoration
- The basics of praying the Rosary
- Meditative prayer the 'Five-Finger' prayer at least once a week

Third:

- All the mass responses, including the Confiteor and the Gloria
- Memorize the Apostle's Creed and be able to say it independently
- Know the format of the rosary and can say it independently
- Know the mysteries of the Rosary

Fourth:

- Further exploration of meditation
- Pray the Examen in class once a week.
- Be able describe the steps in an examination of conscience without prompting
- Be able to describe the petitions of the Our Father and apply them to how Christians pray

Fifth:

- Pray the Examen in class once a week.
- Memorize the Nicene Creed and be able to say it independently
- Be able to describe the prayers in the mass and their meaning
- Be able to describe vocal, meditative and contemplative prayer and use them.

Sixth:

- Pray regularly with the psalms -at least once a week
- Be able to describe the different kinds of psalms
- Say the Benedictus and Magnificat and be able to identify them in the Scriptures
- Be introduced to lectio divina and be able to use it to pray the Psalms.

Seventh / Confirmation II:

- Memorize the prayer to the Holy Spirit
- Learn Ignatian meditation while studying the Gospels and use it or lectio divina at least once a week

Eighth / Confirmation III:

- Further exploration of all prayer forms mentioned above.
- Pray meditatitively using lectio divina once a week
