What is Heifer?

Heifer International is a wonderful organization that provides breeding pairs of animals to farmers in over 100 countries. The animals supply meat, wool and fur, eggs and milk. They also have young, which are passed on to other families in that local community. This support of sustainable agriculture helps families feed themselves, as well as provide income that covers education and medical expenses. **You can find out more about them at heifer.org.**

What is Read to Feed?

Students solicit pledges for the reading that they will do during Lent. They can set goals for books, for pages, for chapters or for minutes per day. Friends and family agree to pay for each page/chapter/book/minute read. It is like a track-a-thon, but instead of running, there is reading!

What kinds of things can be read?

Anything that you can think of! Reading for school counts, as well as free reading for pleasure.
