

***Scripture Texts Applying
to the Labyrinth***

Exodus 13:18 So God led the people by the roundabout way of the wilderness.

Deuteronomy 5:33 You must follow exactly the path that the Lord your God has commanded you, so that it may go well with you, and that you may live long in the land that you are to possess.

Job 31:4 Does he not see my ways, and number all my steps? (Job is speaking of God)

Ps 25:4 Make me to know your ways of Lord, teach me your paths.

Isaiah 30:20-21 Though the Lord may give you the bread of adversity and the water of affliction, yet your Teacher will not hide himself anymore, but your eyes shall see your Teacher. And when you turn to the right or when you turn to the left, your ears shall hear a word behind you saying: "THIS IS THE WAY, WALK IN IT." (Judah is encouraged to turn to the Lord.)

Wisdom 7:6 ...there is for all one entrance into life, and one way out.

Sirach 4:11, 17-18 Wisdom leads her children and gives help to those who seek her... For at first she will walk with them on torturous paths; She will bring fear and dread upon them and she will torment them by her discipline until she trusts them, and she will test them with her ordinances. Then she will come straight back to them again and gladden them, and will reveal her secrets to them.

Matthew 7:14 For the gate is narrow and the road is hard that leads to eternal life, and there are few who find it.

John 14:4 And you know the place where I am going. (Jesus to the disciples.)
